



Frequently Asked Questions:

Question: Is GreekLifeEdu different from AlcoholEdu for College?

Answer:

Yes. GreekLifeEdu is a specialized program that targets alcohol, hazing, and sexual assault designed to better meet the needs of students joining Delta Tau Delta. Some institutions require new students to take AlcoholEdu for College or another alcohol education program; however, all new members, regardless of their institutional practices, are required to take GreekLifeEdu.

Question: Will there be information in GreekLifeEdu that is a repetition of AlcoholEdu for College?

Answer:

Yes. There will be approximately 10%-20% content overlap between GreekLifeEdu and AlcoholEdu, depending on the specific student pathway. This repetition has been created by design; for students who complete both AlcoholEdu and GreekLifeEdu, the repetition will serve to reinforce critical content, supporting better decisions and thus benefiting both you and your students.

Question: If a member completes AlcoholEdu for College for their institution, do they need to complete DTAA: Powered by GreekLifeEdu?

Answer:

Yes. AlcoholEdu for College is designed to complement GreekLifeEdu to ensure efforts of institutions and Delta Tau Delta are in sync, rather than competing. Therefore, all new members must complete DTAA: Powered by GreekLifeEdu.

Question: Will members be able to transfer their credit from AlcoholEdu to GreekLifeEdu?

Answer:

No. There will be no need to request a transfer of credit, because GreekLifeEdu is a different program from AlcoholEdu for College. The transfer of credit feature was originally designed to assist with the logistics of providing the same program to both Delta Tau Delta and campuses. All new members will be required to complete DTAA: Powered by GreekLifeEdu even if they have already taken AlcoholEdu for College.
